1. Bike Parking

Louise obtained 2 quotes for cycle hoops and toast racks. The group agreed that individual hoops seemed to be a better option. Broxap quote is the cheaper of the two. While Broxap quoted for installation YPL did not. We will need to obtain further quotes from local companies for installation.
