### **The Local Food Group Meeting**

- **Future Workshops**  
CCF Funding will end March 2011 and we still have budget for Reskilling workshops. Currently we have a Fruit Tree Pruning workshops scheduled for Saturday 6 November. Andy highlighted that we can still take suggestions and turn them into workshops. Currently in planning are seaside forage and cheese making. Louise mentioned that the bakery sub group are hoping to organise an event in the New Year. Suggested on the evening were Game Preparation and Pasteurisation. Anyone with ideas should email Louise.
- **Community Bulk Buying Update**  
It was suggested that as the members of the sub group were not present that this is carried forward.
- **Community Bakery Update**  
Louise provided an update. The group are hoping to run a trial delivery service in November. We have a list of interested parties and will be taking this forward over the next month.
- **Reallocation of Food Storage Feasibility Funding**  
This was raised at the coordinating group meeting. This is the same budget as the Community Bulk Buying scheme so there is no scope for reallocation at the moment.

- **Future Funding**

This has been added to the agenda to get members of the food group thinking about how we move forward once the CFF Funded projects have ended. How we can become a self sustaining group and how we would like that group to look. No decision was made at the meeting.

- Viv Collier was interested in what progress was being made with on line barter system and what, if any, health and safety issues have been raised around this. We have not experienced any problems around. While the exchange has not yet been widely used we hope to launch it to the wider community at an event in the New Year.
